LOG IN

- · Enter your email address/user name and password
- Check "Remember me for 2 weeks" to skip the log-in step in the future.
- · Click the "Log In" button
- To log in as another user, choose <u>Log Out</u>




PHOTOS TAB

- The newest photo from this project is displayed upon login
- · Select an icon to open or close photo tool menus



CALENDAR AND TOOLS

- Select a date on the calendar and a time on the drop-down menu to display the photo
- · Select action: full-screen mode, download photo, email photo, or print photo

TIMELINE



- Select filter type in the first drop-down menu: All, Hourly, Daily, Weekly, Monthly
- Select additional filter parameter(s) on the secondary drop-down menu: Example: Hourly closest to 0:00
- Select the "Filter" button to apply your filter parameters
- Use the scroll bar to view photo timeline
- Select a photo on the timeline to load



Move to previous/next photo

${\sf Q}$ zoom

- Zoom using the mouse scroll wheel or by dragging the zoom slider
- Internet Explorer: click the zoom slider to activate
- Drag the zoomed photo to move

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LIVE STREAM TAB

Press the Play icon on the video screen to start the live stream





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- Use the Zoom slider to zoom in or out
- Use the Snapshot button to save a photo from the live stream

Timelapse

There are three ways to view time-lapse movies from the Timelapse menu:

1. Instant View

To instantly view a movie with all of the project's daytime photos click the **Load** button and wait for the movie to load in the video player. Once the movie has finished loading, click the play button* (**>**) to begin watching.

* Don't see the Play button? If your screen does not display the play button (▶) underneath the video player, try adjusting the view of your Internet browser. You may need to zoom out the browser's view to 75%-90%. Adjusting the percentage of zoom is commonly found in the Settings menu of your Internet browser.

2. Create a Movie

To create and view a movie with your desired dates and times, follow the steps below:

- · Select start and end dates
- Select daily start and end times or select Include all times to use all available photos
- Uncheck box to exclude weekends
- Select the playback speed
- Select Load and wait for the movie to load in the video player.
- Once the movie has finished loading, click the play button
 (►) to begin playback

3. Download a Movie

To make a time-lapse movie downloadable, follow the steps from #2 and click **Load**. After the movie has loaded in the video player, click the **Make Downloadable** button and select/deselect your preferred parameters:


- Uncheck the Timestamps box to remove timestamps from the downloaded video
- Select the video size
 - Note: Large (4K) videos can take a long time to render.
- Click the Submit Job button

When your movie has rendered, it will appear in the Downloadable Timelapse Videos list.

- Select Refresh C to update the list
- Select Info for details about this video
- Select Download to save the video to your computer







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
